Through BVL funding, veterans recuperating at VA Medical Centers across the country can enjoy a movie, spend the afternoon at a ball game, play a video game, be visited by friendly Labrador, or try their hand at painting. BVL is America's only national sports organization specifically devoted to those who have served our country.

Although the roots of BVL are in bowling, BVL funding supports a wide range of other sports and exercise activities. When the Hunter Holmes McGuire VAMC in Richmond, Va. constructed a new gym for their Polytrauma unit, BVL stepped in to purchase cardio machines, free weights and a number of other pieces of equipment.

Music is another popular therapy in which BVL is very involved. For almost 30 years, BVL has sponsored the tours of the energetic and effervescent entertainment troupe "Re-Creation." Each year, a new edition of these young singers travels across the nation, performing for veterans in VA Medical Centers and State Homes, bringing their special version of musical therapy.
